## Backpacks for Kinnaman Elementary School



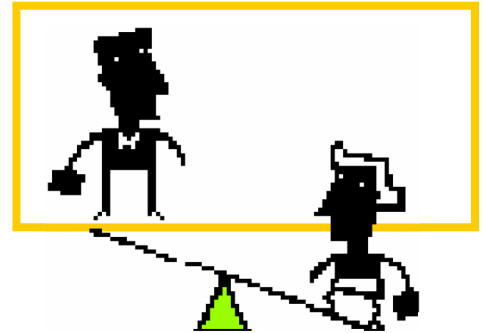
